POLICY

Police Investigators are Police Officers temporarily assigned to the Investigative Unit of the Police Department.

TRAINING ASSIGNMENTS

All Police Officers will receive specific investigative training while completing an Investigative Training Assignment. Police Officers will enter this assignment, on a seniority basis, after successful completion of their new employee probationary period.

New Investigator training is coordinated by the Lieutenant of the Investigative Unit. Basic skills necessary for conducting criminal investigations will be relayed to the employee during this training assignment.

Upon meeting the goals established in the training program, the new Investigator will be eligible for more complex case assignments, night time call-in, and future assignments to the Investigative Unit. Issuance of a personally assigned vehicle may also take place upon completion of the training program.

INVESTIGATION ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments to the Investigative Unit are temporary. The assignment duration may vary depending on the specific assignment, the needs of the department or the needs of the employee. Investigative assignments may be extended if a need is identified by the Police Administration.

Investigators may be issued a personally assigned vehicle, subject to policy 8.7, Personally Assigned Vehicles.
