TITLE: HANDLING OF INTOXICATED ADULT PERSONS

POLICY

When an intoxicated adult is observed in a public place (e.g., business place, dance halls, office buildings, hospitals, hotels, restaurants, etc.), AND is not under arrest or being detained for a crime, a Police Officer shall do one of the following:

- A. Take the person to a detoxification center, prepare the admittance forms, and write a general report.
- B. Take the person home and make a general report of the incident. The intoxicated person shall only be released to a sober, responsible adult.
- C. Take the person to a medical facility and make a general report of the incident.
